 So many nights I just dream of the ocean, God, I wish I was sailin' a - gain

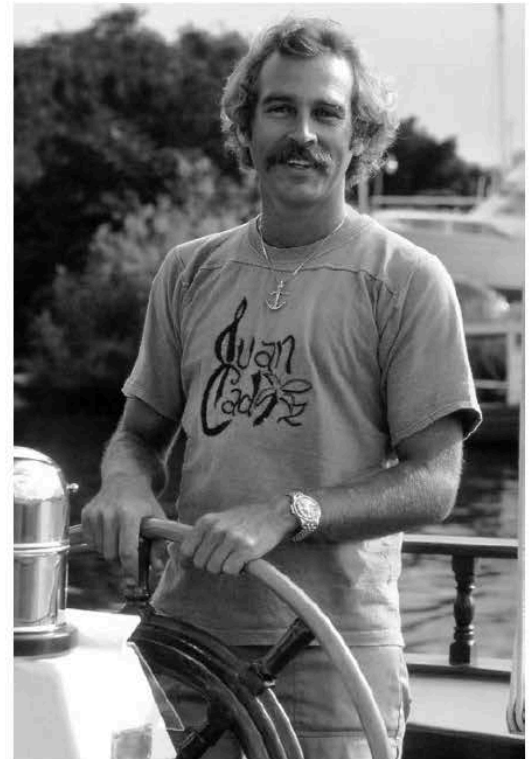
Oh yesterday's over my shoulder
