

Intro: play one G chord to get pitch, then
count off 1, 2, 3...

VERSE 1: It's been a ^{G C G} hard day's night, and I've been working like a ^F dog, ^G
^{G C G} It's been a hard day's night, I should be sleeping like a log, ^{F G}
 But when I ^C get home to you, I find the things that you do, ^{D7}
^{G C7 G} Will make me feel alright.

VERSE 2: You know I ^{G C G} work all day, to get you money to buy you things, ^{F G}
^{G C G F G} And it's worth it just to hear you say, you're gonna give me everything.
 So why on ^C earth should I moan, 'cause when I get you alone, ^{D7}
^{G C7 G} You know I'll be o-kay.

BRIDGE: When I'm ^{Bm Em} home, everything seems to be right; ^{Bm}
^{G Em C D7} When I'm home, feeling you holding me tight, tight, yeah.

VERSE 3: It's been a ^{G C G} hard day's night, and I've been working like a ^F dog, ^G
^{G C G F G} It's been a hard day's night, I should be sleeping like a log,
 But when I ^C get home to you, I find the things that you do, ^{D7}
^{G C7 G} Will make me feel alright,

ENDING: You know I ^{G C7 G} feel all right,
^{G C7 F F G} You know I feel all right.

SOLO (after first ending):
 G - C - G ----- F - G
 G - C - G ----- F - G
 BACK to Bridge
 then to ending
